Take German 100 in the Spring, and German 230 in the Summer! Both classes meet MTWTh 10-12 & 1-3

German 100 is an intensive introductory course for students who have not previously studied German. Learning a new language for the first time is exciting and fun. The course focuses on engaging students' interest, creativity, and sense of humor.

- Start speaking German on the first day of class!
- No textbook but we will read a popular children's book (Oh, wie schön ist Panama), and watch two feature films as well as two Oscar-nominated short films. ...and we will explore the culture and language of the German speaking countries first-hand via the Easy German series (easygerman.org).
- Learn the most frequent German words; flashcards are ready for you on Quizlet.
- Regular low-stakes assessments to help you master the material (failed assessments can be re-taken twice). A final cumulative vocabulary quiz, but no final exam or chapter tests.
- Full lesson plans for each day are available for students to (p)review outside of class.
- Deutschtische twice/week during the lunch hour break provide authentic conversation practice and promote community-building with classmates.
